

1 INSTALL APP OR GO ONLINE

Tip: Regardless of your device you will need to be connected to the Internet to access Hoopla

If you have a tablet or smartphone you will need to download the free app from your app store.

- iOS Device (iPhone/iPad/iPod Touch) - App Store
- Android Device - Google Play Store
- Kindle Fire/HD - Amazon App Store

2 SIGNING UP FOR HOOPLA

Through App:
Select Sign Up at the bottom of the log-in screen.

Through Website:
Click the Get Started button in the center of the Hoopla homepage. A window should pop up in the middle of the screen.

tip: on mobile devices you may select the Licking County Library pin on the map

3 CREATING AN ACCOUNT

Enter a valid email address and create a password for your Hoopla account.

Select Licking County Library under the Choose Library menu.

Then, enter your Licking County Library card number.

Once all of the required information has been filled in, click Sign Up.

Tip: If you need your library card or PIN number, see any library staff member and we can help.

4 BORROWING

Once you've found a title you would like to borrow, click the icon of the item. Click Borrow to check the item out.

After borrowing a title, a play button will appear under the title's cover. Click here to play the title.

Movie and TV Titles can be checked out for three days, Music Albums for seven days; Audio Books, eBooks, and comics for twenty-one days.

Titles automatically return. You are allowed a total of fifteen checkouts per month.

Note: All titles can either be downloaded to your device or streamed over an internet connection.
